Dear Ateneo Hearter Parents and Guardians,

Greetings of love from the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus!

Thank you for your continuous trust and support in your child's holistic development. With health and safety among our ongoing major priorities, we journey together in recovery from Typhoon Odette and the pandemic.

Jesuit Education affirms adaptive and creative formation with the learner's situation at heart. Thus, Sacred Heart School – Ateneo de Cebu temporarily shifts to **Offline Modular Learning** for all grade school pupils from **January 17, 2022 - February 11, 2022**. We continue to provide a holistic, independent, and self-directive delivery of instruction with no actual interaction (*neither synchronous nor asynchronous*) between the learners and teachers within the post Odette learning continuity plan.

With the **Offline Modular Learning** set-up, each Ateneo Hearter will be provided with the **HeART (Hearter's Academic & ReflecTion) Learning Package**. It contains the (1) alternative E-Pathway to Competence, (2) Homeroom-Guidance Program, and (3) HeART modules from January 17-February 11, 2022.

The HeART Learning Package will be made available for **ALL Ateneo Hearters** through the following:

- a. E-mail – The entire HeART Learning Package will be sent to the parent's e-mail registered during the enrollment.
- b. MS Teams – The contents will be uploaded to the established platforms using the official Learning Management System (LMS).
 - **Advisory Class Teams:** E-Pathway to Competence (E-Pathway Channel) and HGP modules (HGP Channel)
 - **Subject Teams:** HeART modules (Modules Channel)

For those who have **neither access to electricity nor internet**, printed copies will be provided. We would like to appeal, however, that a request be made to your respective class advisers to signify your commitment to avail and pick-up onsite the HeART Learning Package on or before Thursday, January 13, 2022. A minimum amount will be charged to your child's account to cover the additional expenses incurred in the printing and distribution of the modules.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How does learning look like in a full offline modular learning?

In a full offline modular learning, content, instructions, and assessments will be delivered through the HeART learning modules. Just like Ateneo H.E.A.R.T.E.R. Online, the Post Odette offline modular learning continues to provide independent and self-directed learning, this time without internet connectivity.

In this set-up, formative assessments such as practice activities and worksheets and their answer keys are provided for immediate feedback and self-monitoring. For pupils who will need more assistance, remediation will be provided when the regular learning set-up resumes.

The overview, procedures, and rubrics of Performance Tasks will also be provided. When online learning resumes, time will be provided for the making and submission.

Tests (Written Works) are put on hold until the regular learning delivery mode is back.

Although pupils are empowered to be independent and self-directive, they still must follow the schedule provided by the E-Pathway to Competence. This is to ensure that they can accomplish the learning tasks within the appropriate time and pacing.

2. What is the HeART Learning Package?

The HeART Learning Package is Sacred Heart School – Ateneo de Cebu Grade School Department's toolkit in response to the challenge of the Post Typhoon Odette aftermath and the pandemic. It contains the (1) alternative E-Pathway to Competence, (2) Homeroom-Guidance Program, and HeART Learning Modules.

The alternative E-Pathway to Competence contains the schedule of subjects and activities to be accomplished from January 17-February 11, 2022. It features the self-paced and discipline-focused daily activities. Instead of following the 6-day Cycle, the given activities are to be accomplished one subject at a time. This is considering the alternative learning modality as part of our recovery from Typhoon Odette and the pandemic.

The Homeroom-Guidance Program modules provide learning opportunities for pupils to debrief and process their Post Typhoon Odette experiences, and further learn self-motivation and discipline.

The HeART modules feature the learning experiences for all the subjects.

3. Who will supervise my child's learning?

In a full online modular learning, we continue to rely on parents and guardians to co-facilitate the learning of the pupils.

4. What will be the programs that will be covered by the HeART Learning Package?

The HeART Learning Package covers the HGP, CLF, Chinese, Filipino, Mother Tongue (Grades 1-3), Language, Math, MAPE, ICT & HE (Grades 4-6), Reading, Science (Grades 2-6), and Social Studies.

Special academic programs such as Magis, ASAP, and AMP are put on hold.

5. When will be the submission of the pending Performance Tasks or the tests that were supposed to be due on the first week of January 2022?

All forms of assessment (either Written Works or Performance Tasks) will be collected when the regular learning set-up resumes.

6. What are the procedures in acquiring a printed copy of the HeART Learning Package?

- a. Send your request for a printed copy of the HeART Learning Package to either the GSPO (e-mail, mobile, and landline number) or the class adviser (MS Teams, or e-mail). Include your child's/children's name, and grade and section.
- b. If able, accomplish the acknowledgement slip and submit it to the assigned school personnel during the onsite distribution.
